### CATLIN GABEL BUS ROUTES

### CATLIN GABEL BUS SCHEDULE

Morning pickup routes begin at 7 a.m. All buses arrive on campus by 7:45 a.m. Buses leave campus at 3:30 p.m. with the last drop-off at 4:22. Younger learners are walked to the bus.

### COST OF BUS SERVICE

Packages include annual or half-year passes with morning, afternoon, and round-trip options. Passes range from \$49 to \$98 per month with discounts for siblings. Single-ride rates also available. **Students may be eligible for reduced fees.**

### TRIMET

The #20 Trimet bus stops at the main entrance to the school and the Sunset Transit Center is a ten-minute walk from campus.
